

Training Day Process

Each volunteer will be given a checklist of their duties and skills needed to perform their tasks. We will ask new volunteers to pair with a veteran volunteer to review each task and then check off as it is reviewed/performed. When complete with the checklist, sign and date your sheet and turn it into Eric. You are not required to remain at the training session for 4 hours! Only, as long as it takes you to feel comfortable with your duties and complete the checklist. The 4-hour schedule was made to let people know that the boat and other volunteers will be available during that time frame to help you.

Training Day Schedule Conflicts

If you cannot make one of these dates, we ask you to call Eric (218-340-8683) to arrange a time or shadow another volunteer on one of the early scheduled regular trips to complete your checklist. You will need to check with the captain of that trip to make sure there is room for you to shadow.

For insurance purposes and to insure the safety of everyone, we require each volunteer to have a completed checklist with their signature on file before they can participate in an actual trip.
